MINUTES OF THE ZONING & PLANNING COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING April 14, 2022

On April 14, 2022 at 10:00 a.m., Vice-Chairperson Jim Thies opened the Monona County Zoning & Planning Commission Public Hearing on the draft Floodplain Ordinance #67.

There was no public present and no comments in writing for the public hearing. Sandy shared with the commission that this ordinance was the model ordinance from the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and has the required information necessary to meet the FEMA requirements.
