## MONONA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING SEPTEMBER 17, 2024

The Monona County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. o'clock on Tuesday, September 17, 2024 in the boardroom of the courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Chairman Fox presiding.
