

**MONONA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
APRIL 28, 2026**

The Monona County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. o'clock on Tuesday, April 28, 2026, in the boardroom of the courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Chairman Fox presiding. Other Supervisors present: Tom Brouillette and Vince Phillips. Supervisor Absent: None. Also present was Auditor Peggy A. Rolph.

Motion was made by Supervisor Phillips, seconded by Supervisor Brouillette, to approve the agenda. Vote on motion: Ayes: Fox, Brouillette, and Phillips. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Alyssa Henneman was present to inquire about having a water stop at her residence during RAGBRAI. The Board informed Ms. Henneman that they passed a resolution on April 21, 2026, not allowing vendors in the unincorporated areas of the county due to safety reasons.
