JUNE 23, 2026

The Monona County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m. o'clock on Tuesday, June 23, 2026, in the boardroom of the courthouse in Onawa, Monona County, Iowa with Chairman Fox presiding. Other Supervisors present: Tom Brouillette and Vince Phillips. Supervisor Absent: None. Also present was Auditor Peggy A. Rolph.

Area Road Foremen and Maintenance Shop Foreman are management, salaried and exempt from overtime. Area Road Foremen and Maintenance Shop Foreman will not be paid overtime for work over 40 hours in a week; work in excess of 40 hours per week may be required at times to ensure appropriate performance of essential job functions. Holidays, personal leave, vacation, and sick leave will be the same as outlined in the Monona County Handbook. Area Road Foremen are expected to give 4 weeks minimum notice before resignation or retirement. The Office Manager and the Assistant to the Engineer are paid hourly and not exempt from overtime. These positions will be paid at time and a half for work over 40 hours in a week, but work over 40 hours per week is not normally anticipated for the Office Manager. Holidays, personal leave, vacation, and sick leave will be the same as outlined in the Monona County Handbook. The employees in these positions are expected to give 4 weeks minimum notice before resignation or retirement.

WHEREAS: the Iowa Legislature through House File 2490 has amended Iowa's Open Meetings statute to require every governmental body to annually designate a prominent and conspicuous place for posting notice of its meetings;

WHEREAS: beginning on July 1, 2026, such notice must be visible at all times for at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting for which notice is being given; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR MONONA COUNTY, IOWA:

Section 1. At least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the commencement of each meeting of the Monona County Board of Supervisors from June 30, 2026, through and including January 4, 2027, the Monona County Auditor shall post a meeting agenda, including the time, date, and place of meeting, on the bulletin board across from the Auditor's Office, the main doors of the Courthouse on the South and East side of the building, and the Monona County Website (mononacountyiowa.gov). If an agenda that was previously posted needs to be amended, not less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting. It will be marked with the word "Amended" and will identify the amended provisions.

Section 2. At their January 4, 2027, organizational meeting, and at every annual organizational meeting thereafter, the Monona County Board of Supervisors shall designate the place at which notice of its meetings shall be posted for the following year.
